Q: I love my new peep toes, but can I still wear them when it gets cold out?

As long as the shoes are made of sturdy material (leather, for example, not flimsy satin), you can absolutely wear peep toes in winter, says Meghan Cleary, author of the shoe bible, *The Perfect Fit*.
